Food and Gift Booths

Year after year, Festival of Nations booth vendors offer thousands of visitors tasty treats and handmade traditional gifts representing more than 50 ethnicities. The festival is an opportunity for people of all cultures to work in harmony, leaving behind past or present conflicts in other parts of the world.

Who may participate:

Ethnic organizations, ethnic businesses, immigrants, or those of the heritage being represented as long as:

- **VENDOR AND MAJORITY OF BOOTH WORKERS ARE OF THE ETHNICITY BEING REPRESENTED.**
- All food/gifts being sold is representative of the designated ethnicity.
- Participant is in good standing with the International Institute. For instance, all fees from the previous year including damage charges and late fees must have been paid.
- **Applicants will be considered in the order received. Spaces are limited**

Food Booth Space Rental:(10' x 30' space)

Business Rate	\$700
Ethnic Organization* Rate	\$575
Refundable Security Deposit	\$200

Optional Fees:

Electric (40 amps, food booth only)	\$325
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Food and gift booth vendors are also responsible for paying sales tax to the Missouri Department of Revenue.

***Qualifications to receive the Ethnic Organization pricing:**

Must have one of the following and return a copy of the form along with the contract and a 50% deposit:

- 501(c)3 IRS determination letter
- Tax exempt letter

Information Booths

Information booth space is available to organizations interested in promoting their services, special events or other activities.

In accordance with the purpose and policy, the Festival only allows groups who:

- Are community groups, not for profit, charitable, or otherwise not a money making corporate entity. Due to limited space organizations with services for new Americans and neighborhood organizations will receive priority.
- Are not a political party or religious organization.
- Are appropriate for the diverse audience and age range of the festival goers, especially the foreign-born.
- Government Agencies (local, state, and federal agencies) which are reaching out to new Americans and other festival visitors for educational purposes and engagement. Booths for lobbying and electioneering purposes are prohibited within the festival grounds.
- All successful applicant organizations must be in good standing with the International Institute.

Information booths applications will be accepted until all spaces all filled. You are responsible for providing you own table, chairs and tent. To request a contract call (314) 773-9090, ext. 121 or juelfsc@iustl.org.
